

## Lunchtime Volunteer Guidelines

- 1. Arrival: Sign in at the front desk and make your way to the River's Edge, located next to the cafeteria. Select a book from the glass display case.
  - a. Remember to arrive 5-10 minutes early to select your book and orient yourself. Students only have 30 minutes to eat lunch and clean up, so we want to maximize reading time with them!

## 2. Picking up students:

- a. Walk into the cafeteria
- b. Look for the teacher assigned to MM at lunch:
  - i. Lunch A: Mrs. Stinson
  - ii. Lunch B: Ms. Lundquist
  - iii. Lunch C: Ms. Reeves
  - iv. Lunch D: Ms. Watson
- c. Take the 4 students for the day out to the River's Edge with their lunch.
- d. If two Bowdoin students are volunteering, you'll have two small groups.
- 3. **Read-aloud setup:** Have the students sit at the bottom of the River's Edge and use the step above them as a table for eating. You can sit a couple of steps up and hold the book low, or use the adult chair nearby.
- 4. **Wrapping up:** Finish reading 8-10 minutes before the lunch period is over so students can clean up and be dismissed with their class. For example, if your lunch period is 11-11:30, try to finish reading around 11:20.
